

# Teamwork Makes the Dreamwork in Lewiston's Lead Prevention Efforts



Healthy Androscoggin has been busy the past 6 months working with the Lewiston Lead Program and Clarity Property Services. Between December 2022 and May 2023, there have been **27** units completed. This is **TRIPLE** the amount of completed units there was last year alone! With staff turnover and changes to the outreach process, the lead team has been able to create an efficient and effective way to better connect with residents directly in their home.



## WHATS THE PROCESS?

When a landlord or homeowner enrolls in the program for lead remediation, a lead inspection is scheduled with Clarity Property Services after income verification is done by the Lewiston Lead Program. After it is completed, all three organizations attend the lead inspection!



Hannah Dieterich, our lead poisoning prevention coordinator, Thomas Moore, the Lewiston Lead Program Manager, and Stephanie Boutin, the Lead Inspector with Clarity Property Services, all attend the lead inspection to not only see where lead paint is located in the home/units, but to talk to residents about the effects of lead poisoning and how to prevent it, especially for families with small children.
