

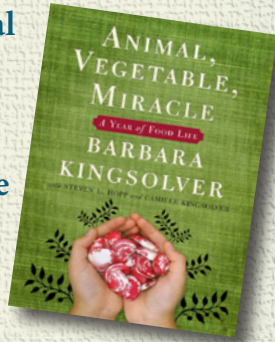


LEWISTON-AUBURN'S ONE BOOK/ONE COMMUNITY

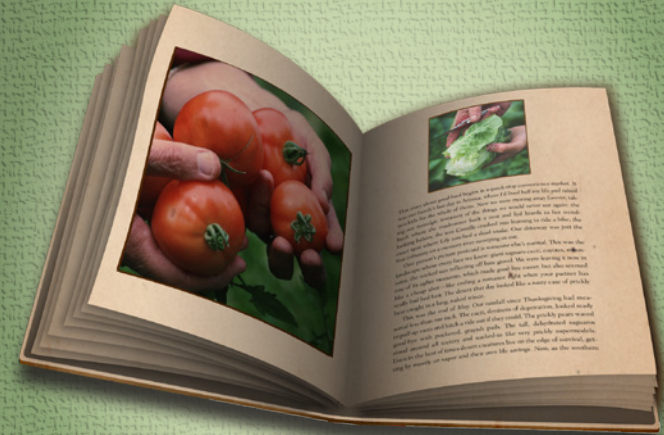
